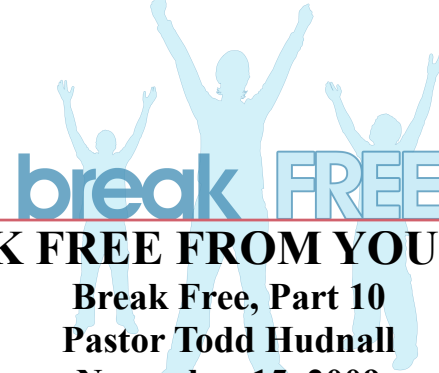


Connection Group Discussion Questions

And patience develops strength of character in us and helps us trust God more each time we use it until finally our hope and faith are strong and steady.”

Isa. 42:1-3 (NKJ) “Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, my Elect One in whom My soul delights! I have put My Spirit upon Him; he will bring forth justice to the Gentiles. He will not cry out, nor raise His voice, nor cause His voice to be heard in the street.
